



Parish Invitations to Bishops

The Diocesan Bishop will accept invitations to preside at major anniversary services (e.g., 10th, 25th, 50th, etc.) if the calendar permits.

If one of the retired bishops of Huron is to be invited to a parish service or event, after consultation with the Bishop's Office, please send a copy of the invitation to the Bishop's Office for information and as a courtesy.

If a parish invites a retired bishop of Huron to a parish event or service, the parish is responsible for paying the bishop's honorarium and travel.

If a bishop from outside of the Diocese of Huron (active or retired) is to be invited, please consult with the Bishop's Office before extending the invitation. (Any bishop, priest or deacon, not holding a licence or General Permit of the Bishop of Huron, who is asked to take part in a service in the Diocese of Huron, must have the permission of the bishop to do so.) (*see Clergy not Licensed to the Bishop of Huron – Section 5.8*)
