

7.--Permission to Officiate

1. No person shall be permitted to officiate, permanently or occasionally, in any parish/congregation of the Diocese unless he/she has been Episcopally and canonically ordained in accordance with the discipline of the Anglican Church of Canada (or a Church which is in full communion with the Anglican Church of Canada) or holds a letter of special permission from the Bishop, or his/her designate.
2. A cleric who does not hold a license or general permit from the Bishop shall not be invited to officiate in any parish/congregation in the Diocese without the prior knowledge and permission of a bishop of the Diocese. This includes, but is not limited to, officiating/preaching at weddings, funerals, baptisms, summer ministry and vacation relief.
3. Every cleric who officiates/preaches in the Diocese is required to inscribe in the Parish's Register of Services his/her name, the date of such officiating and the name of the service.
