Dear Members of Synod:

At the call of Archbishop Linda Nicholls, 13th Bishop of Huron, and as approved by Diocesan Council on July 27, 2019, it is our duty to give notice to elected members of the Synod of the Diocese of Huron of a meeting of the Synod to be held for the election of a Diocesan Bishop of Huron.

Please be informed that an Electoral Synod will take place to elect a Diocesan Bishop of Huron on Saturday, October 26, 2019 at the Cathedral Church of St. Paul in the See City of London, Ontario.

According to the Constitution, this notice will be forwarded to the Lay Delegates registered at the current time. Please be advised that where a Substitute Lay Delegate attended the annual synod in May in place of the Lay Delegate elected in January, the Substitute Delegate has now become the Lay Delegate until the next Vestry election.

Registration for the Electoral Synod will begin at 8:30 am and continue until 10:15 am. A Eucharist will be held at 9:30 am, for those able to be present, followed by the Archbishop calling the 179th Session of the Synod of the Diocese of Huron to Order. The first ballot to be cast at approximately 10:30 am. Refreshments will be available in the Assembly Room throughout the day.

The nominees for election for Diocesan Bishop are determined by Diocesan Council at a meeting held on July 27, 2019, the Provincial House of Bishops and through nominations from members of Synod. Pictures and biographical material of each nominee will be shared by the Electoral Procedures committee in due course.
