Continuing Education Plan (C.E.P.)

All full-time stipendary clergy automatically have a CEP account opened on their behalf on their first day of licensed ministry with a participating diocese. A healthy inquiring mind contributes to your personal well-being and, by extension, to the well-being of your parish/employer and the Church as a whole.

Participants in the plan may use money from their individual accounts for a wide variety of programs, courses, events, retreats, degrees, career assessment, conferences, conventions, tapes, software, books, magazine subscriptions, and resources that will contribute to their effectiveness in their roles.

Contributions for 2019 are \$600; in 2020 \$750 and in 2021 \$900.
Contributions are cumulative and unused funds roll over in your account each year.

As long as the expenditure confers a benefit to your employer, you may use your CEP account to cover up to 75% of the cost of:

- any continuing education program or course of study
- books or other materials and equipment
- computer hardware or software (limited to once every three years.)

The plan is designed to promote lifelong learning among clergy and lay professional. How to use it, is up to you.
